CLEAN IDLING Q&A

In 2024, CARB enacted guidelines that limit diesel trucks and buses from idling more than 5 minutes in California and opt-in states. An exemption for motorcoaches no longer exists.

What is Clean Idling?

Diesel vehicles using an engine that meets the requirements for Clean Idling (less than 10g/hr of CO) and Low Nox Idling are allowed to idle for more than 5 minutes. Applicable vehicles will have a sticker showing they are compliant with the regulation.

Can I Idle everywhere with that engine?

No, CARB defined some restricted areas where Idling is not allowed.

- Schools
- Homes
- Hospitals
- Senior facilities
- Childcare facilities

Within 100 feet of property line





Do I need to buy this Sticker?

All coaches compliant with 2024 Clean Idle regulations will come with the Certified Clean Idle sticker mounted on the driver's side of the coach. If a replacement decal is needed, one can be ordered through Prevost Parts. VIN will be required in order to verify Certified Clean Idle eligibility.
